



## **Requesting Auxiliary Aids or Services, including Sign Language or Oral Interpreters, CART Services, or Documents in Alternate Formats**

Individuals with disabilities who need auxiliary aids or services, including sign language or oral interpreters, computer-assisted real-time transcription (CART) services, or documents in alternate formats (Braille, large print, cassette tapes, electronic format, etc.), to be able to participate in or benefit from a Unified Government program, service, or activity should contact Gordon Criswell, Assistant County Administrator and ADA Coordinator, 701 N. 7<sup>th</sup> St., Kansas City, Kansas 66101, (913) 573-5030, [gcriswell@wycokck.org](mailto:gcriswell@wycokck.org). The Unified Government asks that individuals with disabilities who need auxiliary aids or services contact Mr. Criswell as far in advance as possible (preferably at least two weeks before they are needed).

The Unified Government will not place a surcharge on a particular individual with a disability or any group of individuals with disabilities to cover the costs of measures, such as the provision of auxiliary aids or services or program accessibility, that are required to provide that individual or group with the nondiscriminatory treatment required by the Title II of Americans With Disabilities Act and the regulations implementing it.
