Children 0-18 years of age.

Hours: Mon-Fri: 8:45 a.m.-11 a.m.; 12:45 p.m.-3 p.m.;

Tues/Wed: 3:45 p.m.-6 p.m.; Sat: 8:45 a.m.-11 a.m.

Limited number of walk-in patient visits every session; appointments needed for well child physicals.

- Office visit fee for uninsured patients: \$20.
- Immunization-only visit fee for uninsured patients: \$10.
- Well child check-ups and minor illnesses.
- Specialty care referrals as necessary.
- Most prescription medicines are free.
- Child development and post-partum depression screening.
- Asthma management.
- Kansas Medicaid and Healthwave accepted.
- Serving uninsured families with household incomes up to 200 percent of the federal poverty guidelines.

Hours: Mon-Fri. Please call for specific clinics and scheduled hours of operation.

- Fees vary depending on department; possible income guidelines or other requirements to qualify for services.
 - SRS Medical Eligibility Worker on site.
- Most services are for Wyandotte residents only. However, some services have no residency requirements.
- Preventative Clinic Services includes immunizations, TB tests and epidemiology.
 - Treatment for sexually transmitted diseases (STDs).
 - HIV counseling, testing and referral.
 - Family planning and prenatal.
 - Pediatric primary care clinic.
 - Women, Infant, & Children (WIC).
 - Breast & Cervical Cancer Initiative.

You Need to Bring

Please bring the following documents (only for those persons for whom you are applying for coverage) to assist in determining eligibility for Kansas Medicaid, HealthWave, or a discounted fee for services.

- **Photo Identification Card**
Please bring the following identification: Birth certificates, immunization records and Social Security card.
- **Any Health Insurance Information**
(If applicable.)
- **Identification of Home Address**
Example: Envelope postmarked within the last 10 days containing your name and address OR a notarized letter from the home owner where you live, stating your current address.
- **Names of Family Members and Their Dates of Birth**
Include immediate family members only: spouse and children.
- **Proof of Total Household Income**
Example: Income tax statement, a notarized letter stating income or a pay stub.
