

I. POLICY

There will be recreational and leisure time activities provided in the Detention Center designed to fulfill individual interest, healthy bodies and attitudes.

II. PROCEDURE

A. Rules and Regulations:

1. Each housing unit will provide sufficient space and equipment to permit both individual and group activities.
2. Recreational materials for use in the housing units will be made available to the detainees on a regular basis.
3. All detainees including those with disabilities will have the opportunity to participate in physical recreation. Detainees are not required to participate, but will be encouraged to participate a minimum of three hours a week. Detainees shall be encouraged to take every opportunity for physical recreation available to them.
4. The Pod Officer shall determine the number of detainees permitted to exercise at any one time.
5. All detainees participating in recreation will be supervised. Security will be maintained at all times.

6. All equipment, games, cards, etc., shall be maintained and stored properly at the end of each activity.
7. Detainees are required to abide by the detainees rules and regulations. Any violation will be subject to disciplinary action.
8. Detainees housed in administrative and/or disciplinary confinement will be permitted to participate in recreation in accordance with the procedures and conditions set forth for such confinement. (See Policy and Procedure, Section F-185 Disciplinary Procedures.)

B. Types of Activities:

1. Physical recreation includes basketball, walking, and physical training provided it is not disruptive to other detainees, or to the operations of the facility, and done in the recreation area in the pod.
2. Leisure-time activities will be permitted inside the housing units.
 - a. In-Pod activities include table games, cards, chess, checkers, and other activities requiring no direct organization or supervision.

C. Recreation Schedule:

1. Detainees may utilize in-pod recreation areas during all open pod times for recreation.
