I. POLICY

The Detention Center shall make available educational and vocational programs to those detainees who wish to take advantage of such activities.

II. PROCEDURE

A. General Rules and Regulations

1. The Detention Center shall make available educational programs to all detainees, including those with limited English proficiency and with disabilities.
2. The Administrator shall provide and make available adequate space to conduct such programs.
3. Detainees will be encouraged to participate in the available educational programs.
4. Sign up sheets for specific educational programs are posted on the pod bulletin boards one day prior to the scheduled program. Inmates must sign up in advance by name and room number in order to attend.
5. Detainees who participate in any educational programs shall abide by the detainee rules and regulations. Any violation of the rules and regulations can result in disciplinary action and termination from such programs.

B. Programs Available

1. Family Reunification
2. Parenting from Prison
3. Life Skills
4. Financial Management
5. Job Readiness

C. Volunteers

1. The Programs Department will utilize volunteers from various organizations and civic groups to assist in the development and implementation of inmate programs.
2. Program availability and types will be offered to the extent that resources allow.
3. Some programs will require inmates to obtain minimum classification before participation, as security requires.
