



UG Adds Transit Service to Turner Recreation Commission

The Unified Government Transit (UGT) is now providing bus service to Turner Recreation Commission.

UGT route #115-Kansas Ave began providing service the recreation center on Monday, April 4.

“This small change to route #115 will have a positive impact for the residents of Wyandotte County,” said Unified Government Transit Director Emerick Cross. “People in the neighborhood surrounding the recreation center will have better access to affordable public transportation. And all residents of Wyandotte County will have more convenient access to the resources at Turner Recreation Commission via UGT public transit.”



The route will continue to run every 60 to 70 minutes on weekdays. Times for the stops at 7th St. & Armstrong, 7th St. & Central, 10th St. & Kansas, and Indian Springs Transit Center will remain the same or change by one minute. Scheduled times for 42nd & Speaker Rd. will change, and a scheduled stop will be added for the Turner Recreation Commission. The eastbound and westbound route between 42nd St. and 55th St. will change.

New #115-Kansas Ave. schedules will be available on buses, in schedule racks and online beginning the week of March 21.
