



## WOULD YOU KNOW WHAT TO DO?

In 95 percent of all emergencies, the victim or bystander provides the first immediate assistance on the scene.

CERT prepares you to help yourself, your family and your neighbors in the event of a disaster. During an incident, emergency services personnel may not be able to reach everyone right away. As a result of CERT training, you will be better prepared to respond to disasters for yourself, your family, and your community.

### CERT training teaches participants to:

- Identify and anticipate hazards within their community.
- Learn how to prepare for a disaster.
- Reduce fire hazards in the home and work place.
- Extinguish small fires.
- Assist emergency responders.
- Conduct light search and rescue.
- Develop safe techniques for debris removal and victim extraction.
- Set up treatment areas.
- Apply basic medical techniques.

The training will be held on consecutive Thursdays, from February 25th through April 14th.

Time: 6 – 9 p.m. in the Emergency Operations Center in the basement of KCK City Hall, 701 North 7th Street, KC KS. We will let you in the service entrance shortly before 6:00 p.m.

Participants must be at least 18 years old (16/17 with a parent in attendance at every class). There is no charge but seating is limited to 25 spaces.

Parking is free. Park in the paid lot behind City Hall. Take a ticket if necessary. The lot will be open by the time class is over.
