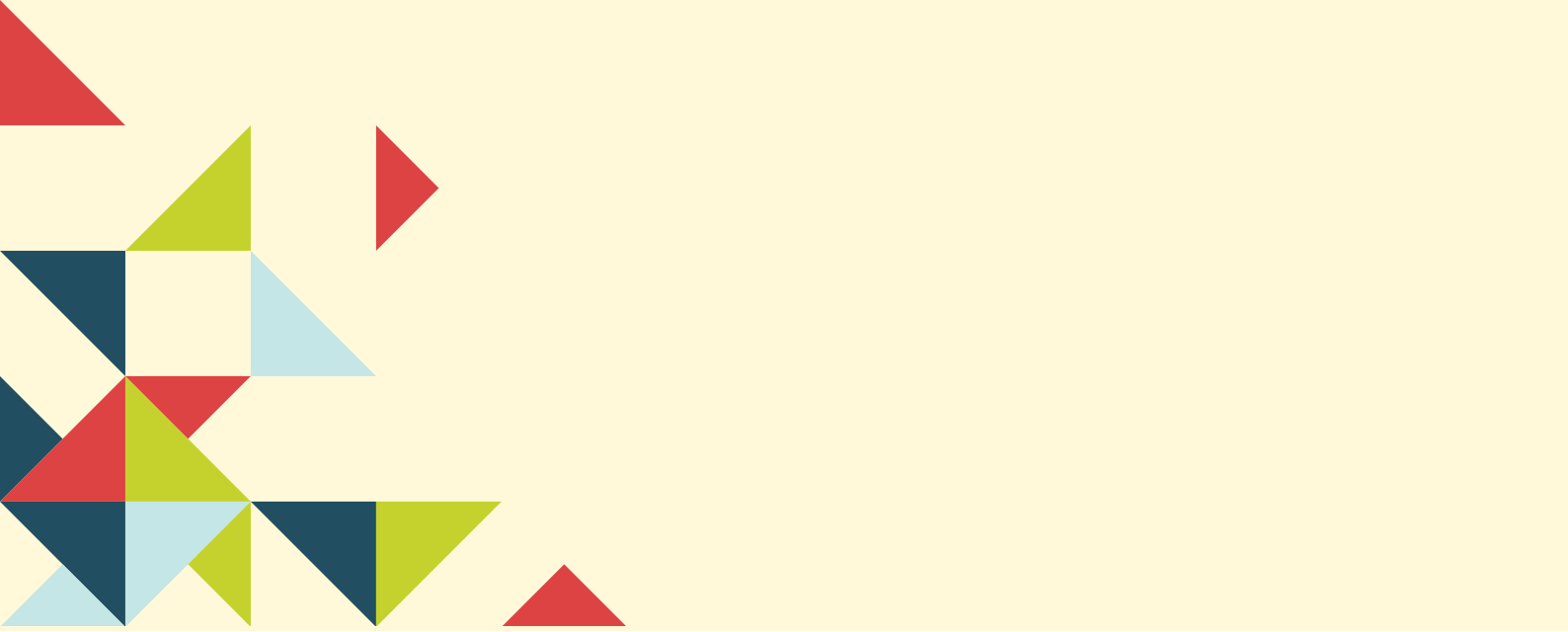

The McKinney-Vento Act provides rights and services to children and youth experiencing homelessness, which includes those who are: sharing the housing of others due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason; staying in motels, trailer parks, or campgrounds due to the lack of an adequate alternative; staying in shelters or transitional housing; or sleeping in cars, parks, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, or similar settings.

Under the McKinney-Vento Act, every local educational agency is required to designate a liaison for homeless children and youth.

Services Offered:

- Transportation to and from school (if applicable)
- Enrollment advocacy
- School supplies, uniforms, books
- Tutoring and counseling
- Referrals for clothes and food
- Hygiene items
- Housing assistance referrals
- Medical and dental vouchers (when available)
- Birth certificate referrals
- Cap and gown fee

Who is eligible for McKinney-Vento services?

A student or family that lives:

- Doubled-up with friends or relatives on a temporary basis
- In a park, motel or campground
- In a shelter

## Naloxone Standing Order

- Kansas has a protocol that allows for pharmacists to dispense naloxone without a prescription.
- The protocol is with a specific pharmacist, it is possible that not all pharmacists on staff will participate. The phone number for the pharmacy is listed on the map to check with the pharmacies.
- To find a participating pharmacy, check the map at <https://pharmacy.ks.gov/k-tracs/pharmacists/naloxone-dispensing>
- All forms of naloxone can be dispensed at a pharmacy. This includes Narcan spray, generic naloxone nasal spray, intramuscular naloxone, and auto-injector naloxone.
- Naloxone dispensed from pharmacies is not reported to K-TRACS. There is no limit to how much naloxone can be dispensed to one person.
- Parental consent is required to dispense naloxone to anyone under 18 years old.
- The pharmacist is required to give counseling on risk factors for opioid overdose, how to respond to an overdose, and information on substance use disorder treatment.
- Naloxone products dispensed at a pharmacy, with or without a prescription, can be billed to pharmacy insurance. Some insurance will cover naloxone with no cost to the individual, others will have a cost set by the insurance company. The pharmacy is able to tell you the cost of the naloxone before it is dispensed.

# Medication Disposal Sites

- Medication disposal bins are for over-the-counter and prescription medications. Pill bottles placed in these bins will be disposed of in a way that protects the environment, keeps medications out of the wrong hands, and protects patient's privacy. Most bins are emptied directly into a disposal canister and are not handled by pharmacy staff or law enforcement.
- Disposal bins cannot accept sharps such as needles or other medical devices. If you do not have a sharps container, a thick plastic container such as laundry detergent bottle can be used.
- All Hy-Vee pharmacy locations have medication disposal bins outside the pharmacy.
- The Walgreens at 78th and State and CVS at 82nd and State both have medication disposal bins.

- The DEA hosts medication takeback days in April and October each year, with takeback sites located at many pharmacies and community centers. These sites will be staffed by local law enforcement, who will collect the medication without looking at the bottles.
- If a medication disposal bin is not easily accessible, the FDA allows for all opioid medications to be flushed down the toilet. Many pharmacies also provide disposal bags that can inactivate controlled substances. A final option can be to mix medications with dirt, kitty litter, or coffee grounds in a sealable plastic container before disposing in the trash.


