The Kansas Department of Health and Environment, Division of Health Care Finance (KDHE-DHCF) is amending the Kansas Medicaid State Plan. Repair rates for maintenance of DMEPOS (durable medical equipment, prosthetics, orthotics and supplies) equipment will be increased to 80% of the Medicare fee schedule.

The proposed effective date for the State Plan Amendment (SPA) is April 1, 2025.

Durable Medical Equipment, Prosthetics, Orthotics and Supplies (DMEPOS) Maintenance and Repair Methods and Standards for Establishing Payment Rates

DMEPOS maintenance and repair services are paid fee schedule rates.

Except as otherwise noted in the plan, state-developed fee schedule rates are the same for both governmental and private providers of DMEPOS maintenance and repair services. The agency's fee schedule rate was set as of April 1, 2025 and is effective for services provided on or after that date.
