

What's Not Accepted?

- Household Hazardous Waste
- Food & Yard Waste
- · Tires & Batteries
- · Storm Debris
- · Refrigerators & Items with Freon
- · Glass, Plastics & Other Recycling
- · Demolition Material & Loose Trash

*\$40 for CRT Computer Screens, \$20 for LCD/Flat Screen TVs, \$40 for CRT TVs. Cash only. Exact change required. Electronics recycling available on Friday only.
